**2004** Fueled by an increased demand for outpatient services, The Surgery Center at Southwoods adds operating rooms, endoscopy suites, clinical space and waiting room capacity, allowing it to serve an additional 10,000 patient visits per year.

**2009** To accommodate more complex surgical procedures that require an inpatient admission, Southwoods is licensed as an acute care hospital and renamed The Surgical Hospital at Southwoods.

**2010** Southwoods Sleep Centers open, specializing in the diagnosis and treatment of sleep disorders.

**2011** Southwoods Physician Services is created, bringing together a network of primary care and specialty physicians, to help coordinate quality, seamless care.

**2014** Southwoods Imaging and the Center for Breast Health open, offering the most comprehensive and advanced imaging technology in the area and bringing the first 3T MRI and first fixed PET/CT scanner to Mahoning County.

2017 Southwoods brings Cardiology and Cardiac Imaging services to its main campus in Boardman.

**2019** The Southwoods Pain & Spine Center opens, giving patients the comprehensive services they need without having to travel out-of-town for this specialized care.

**2020** Southwoods Express Care opens, helping provide fast, easy and convenient access to care that is non-emergent.

**2022** Southwoods announces new home health services for the tri-county area. Southwoods Health at Home delivers skilled care directly to patients' homes. Southwoods brings expert specialty and advanced imaging services to Trumbull County at its new Howland facility.

**2023** The Center for Digestive Health & General Surgery opens, bringing surgeons, gastroenterologists and colorectal specialists together at one convenient location. Southwoods creates the Center for Comprehensive Weight Management & Bariatric Surgery, a comprehensive program that helps combat obesity through medical and surgical weight loss solutions.

**2024** Southwoods announces the addition of outpatient Physical Therapy & Rehabilitation Services. These services allow patients to stay within the Southwoods system, thereby enhancing continuity of care.

"Our focus is always on doing the right thing for local healthcare," said Muransky. "If a service can fill a need or have a positive impact on our patients and the community, we'll pursue it."


#### **Trumbull County Expansion**

#### MAMMOGRAPHY

Digital mammography is the standard of care at Southwoods. Studies show it finds more breast cancers and is especially beneficial for women with dense breasts. Advanced 3D mammography, or tomosynthesis, significantly increases the detection of breast cancer and offers more comfortable testing, faster scan times and less radiation exposure.

#### ULTRASOUND

Ultrasound is commonly used in conjunction with other imaging studies to confirm diagnosis or assist in the identification of breast abnormalities. When combined with advanced elastography applications, ultrasound is particularly effective in helping classify breast lesions and aid in the differentiation between benign and malignant tumors.

A doctor's order is required for these services. Howland imaging hours are Monday – Friday 7:30 am to 4:00 pm. Call 330-965-5100 to schedule your appointment today!
